### **CLINIC #1: Fencers' Personal Equipment Clinic - 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm**

- an ohm meter or multi-function electrical meter that can measure resistance
- 1.5mm and 2mm screwdrivers
- 6 mm Allen key
- one body cord & one weapon that is not working
- something for taking notes
- your best eyes (for seeing tiny parts)
