*Please note that U11 Foil and Cadet Sabre will end at approximately **7pm** on Saturday evening. Junior Foil and Sabre on Sunday are expected to finish at approximately **5-5:30 pm**. Please consider these times when planning your evenings and travel.

*An askfred profile is required in order to register. These profiles can be created for free at www.askfred.net. Registration forms can be completed and handed in at the time of check in. Registration is open to all classified and unclassified fencers.

Entry fees: \$35 for the first event, \$25 for each additional event. For late registrations please add \$10 per event. Payment can be made by cash or cheque (payable to **Fencing-Escrime NB**) at the door.

All fencers are required to have a valid CFF license as well as a competition license in their home province by the registration deadline. This competition is **open to fencers from all provinces**. The 2015 NB Provincials is sanctioned by the CFF.

Competition format:

U11 (Y10) events will be mixed gender with pools of 5-6 when possible. A complete DE table with matches to 10 points will be run.

U13 (Y12) events will be mixed gender with pools of 5-6 when possible. A complete DE table with matches to 10 points will be run.

U15 (Y14) events will be mixed gender with pools of 6-7 when possible. A complete DE table with matches to 15 points will be run.

Cadet//Open events will be separated by gender. If fewer than six (6) participants are registered, the event will be run as mixed gender. Pools will be made of 6-7 fencers when possible and a complete DE table will be fenced with matches to 15 points.

*The DT reserves the right to change the format of any event in order to ensure smooth running of the competition. If on the registration deadline a minimum of six (6) competitors are not registered in a mixed gender youth event, the event may be cancelled. Participants will be informed of this after the registration closes, no less than 5 days prior to the event (March 23).

Equipment: This event will be run in accordance with current FIE regulations. The DT reserves the right to apply or modify these regulations as they see fit in accordance with section t.15 of the FIE Rulebook.

All fencers are required to wear a sous-plastron. In foil, electric bibs are required except in U11 (Y10) events. In sabre, the use of a manchette/electric gauntlet is mandatory. Fencing pants or full length breeches made of a sturdy material without pockets will be permitted. Shorts, non-athletic and yoga pants are not accepted.

Participant Agreement: Please read carefully and sign below:

I understand that there is potential risk for injury inherent in fencing, as in all sports. These include but are not limited to:

- muscular injuries resulting from vigorous exertion and rapid changes of direction of movement.
- bruises resulting from hits received during fencing with an opponent.
- injuries resulting from my failure to properly use the fencing equipment.
- injuries resulting from the breakage of a fencing sword or failure of protective equipment,
- additional risks associated with my travel to and from the fencing event.

Personal protective equipment:

I understand that it is mandatory to wear a properly fitting fencing mask, underarm plastron on the sword arm, breast protector for females, fencing jacket, glove with gauntlet that covers the sword arm sleeve, and fencing breeches or long pants of robust material, all of which must be in good repair.

Safety rules in competition:

I understand that rules have been established for safe conduct at the competition site that I must follow and the organizers have tried to create a safe and controlled environment for participation.

Release:

I am participating voluntarily in this event and agree to accept the risks and be responsible for any injury, equipment damage or other loss that I might incur as a direct or indirect result of my participation in the 2015 NB Provincial Championships. I agree to release Fencing-Escrime NB and their respective directors, officers, staff, coaches, tournament volunteers and officials of all responsibility for such injury, loss or damage.
