DUEL FORT CHAMBLY open mixed epee

DATE :: June 6th, 2015 (rain date June 7th), from 10 am to 4:30 pm.

VENUE :: Fort Chambly, QC. The tournament will be held on a dozen strips marked directly on the ground, with finals inside the walls of the Fort. The spectators will have free access to all spaces adjacent to the Fort.

SCENARIO :: Two rounds of pools (mixed) – No elimitation after the pools – Separate direct elimination tables for men and women.

REGISTRATION :: 50\$ before May 31st, payable at <u>www.escrimemontroyal.com</u> or by cheque mailed to Escrime Mont-Royal. After this date, registration will be 60\$ payable on site in cash, subject to availability (maximum 60 fencers). You will also have to sign a waiver to access the competition site.

EQUIPEMENT :: Mask that passes inspection – Standard clothing and blades (FIE not required) – Good shoes for rough and slippery ground – Sunglasses and sunscreen.

ONSITE SERVICES :: Toilets and drinking fountains will be available inside and outside the Fort. First-aid services will be available in case of injuries. For any equipment repairs or technical problems, the tournament armourer will assist you as much as possible, but there will be no equipment vendors onsite. Fencers should bring their own snacks. The Fourquet Fourchette restaurant next to the Fort will open at 11:30 am.

PUBLIC :: Your family and friends are welcome to share the day outdoors. Historical activities and an initiation to modern fencing for adults and children will entertain the crowd between bouts. The entrance fees to visit inside the Fort are \$5.65 per adult and \$2.90 for youth. Passes will be available for all fencers and tournament officials.

TRANSPORT :: Fort Chambly is located 30 km east of Montreal. The Fort is accessible by car (30 minutes from Montreal / 1h30 from Burlington, VT) or by bus, from the downtown Montreal and Longueuil terminals. WEATHER AND CANCELLATION :: As the tournament is held outdoors, we are at the mercy of the weather. We will do everything we can to hold the event on the announced date, even if it means modifying the format to avoid afternoon showers. In case of heavy rain all day Saturday, the tournament will be postponed to the next day. If the downpour continues Sunday, we will be forced to cancel the tournament this year.
