Overlapping Events: A fencer registered in overlapping events may be asked to withdraw from one event if the overlap causes a significant delay in either event.

Entry Fee: \$30/event, payable at check-in by cash or cheque. Cheques payable to Fundy Fencing Club.

Registration Deadline: Monday, October 9th. \$10 late fee after October 9th.

Registration: Submit this form online and submit a completed & signed waiver (page 2) at check-in.

Format: One round of pools followed by direct elimination to the final. In under 13 foil, elimination bouts will be for 10 hits in two periods of 3 minutes.

CFF ranking: Only events with 6 or more fencers can be submitted for CFF ranking. If there are 6 fencers of each gender in an event, a separate event will be run for each gender. Other events will be run as mixed events.

Membership: All participants must be current members of FENB or equivalent by Oct 14th.

Required Equipment: A fencing sous-plastron

- Masks must have a strap and must be able to pass the 12 kg punch test.
- Fencing breeches/pants must cover at least below the knees and be of sturdy material.
- Knee high socks must be worn with fencing breeches.

2017 FUNDY OPEN TOURNAMENT WAIVER

Participant Agreement: Please read carefully and sign below

I understand that there is potential risk for injury inherent in fencing, as in all sports. These include but are not limited to:

- > Muscular injuries resulting from vigorous exertion and rapid changes of direction of movement.
- > Bruises resulting from hits received during fencing with an opponent.
- > Injuries resulting from my failure to properly use the fencing equipment.
- > Injuries resulting from the breakage of a fencing sword or failure of protective equipment,
- > Additional risks associated with my travel to and from the fencing event.

Personal protective equipment:

I understand that it is mandatory to wear a properly fitting fencing mask, underarm plastron on the sword arm, breast protector for females, fencing jacket, glove with gauntlet that covers the sword arm sleeve, and fencing breeches or long pants of robust material, all of which must be in good repair.

Safety rules in competition:

I understand that rules have been established for safe conduct at the competition site that I must follow and the organizers have tried to create a safe and controlled environment for participation.

Release:

I am participating voluntarily in this event and agree to accept the risks and be responsible for any injury, equipment damage or other loss that I might incur as a direct or indirect result of my participation in the Fundy Open tournament. I agree to release Fencing-Escrime NB, the Fundy Fencing club, Harbourview High School, and their respective directors, officers, staff, coaches, tournament volunteers and officials of all responsibility for such injury, loss or damage.
