Equipment:

- Foil masks must have an electric bib.
- A fencing sous-plastron is required.
- Masks must be able to pass the 12-kg punch test.
- Fencing breeches or pants must cover to at least below the knees and be of sturdy material.
- Knee high socks must be worn with fencing breeches.

Membership: Participants in all events must have a current competitive CFF license.

Late Fee: \$10.00 additional fee on registrations received after November 15, 2017.
