To Register: Please register <u>online here</u>. Bring a completed and signed entry form (below) with you to check-in.

Entry Fee: \$30/event at check-in. Payable by cash or cheque (make cheques payable to Fencing-Escrime NB).

Registration Deadline: <u>Wed., April 25th @ 10:00pm</u>. Late registration will incur a one-time \$10 fee.

Membership: All participants must hold a valid CFF licence at the time of competition.

Overlapping events: A fencer registered in overlapping events may be asked to withdraw from one event if the overlap causes a significant delay in either event.

Format: One round of pools (5 touch bouts or 3 minutes) followed by direct elimination (15 touch bouts or a maximum of three periods of 3 minutes) to final.

- In U13/U11 events, direct elimination bouts will be to 10 touches or a maximum of two periods of 3 minutes.

- When fewer than six fencers are present for each gender, the event shall be mixed. Youth events (U15, U13, U11) will be mixed.

CFF Ranking: Only events with six or more participants will be submitted for CFF ranking. If there are six or more of each gender in a CFF ranked event, a separate event will be run for each gender.

Required Equipment: A fencing sous-plastron is required.

Masks must have a secure strap and be able to pass the 12 kg punch test. Fencing breeches or pants made of durable material must be worn. They must cover below the knee and long socks must be worn with breeches. Female participants must wear a breast protector. Conductive bibs are required for all foil events except U11.

Masks and body cord checks must be completed prior to competing.

Canteen: The Fundy Fencing club will provide a canteen on-site.

Trophies: The gold medalist in each cadet event will be awarded a trophy. The trophies are: Sean Brillant Trophy - Under 17 sabre Barbara Daniel Trophy - Under 17 foil Rick Gosselin Trophy - Under 17 epee

I understand that it is mandatory to wear a properly fitting fencing mask, underarm plastron on the sword arm, breast protector for females, fencing jacket, glove with gauntlet that covers the sword arm sleeve, and fencing breeches or long pants of robust material, all of which must be in good repair.

Safety rules in competition: I understand that rules have been established for safe conduct at the competition site that I must follow and the organizers have tried to create a safe and controlled environment for participation.

Release: I am participating voluntarily in this event and agree to accept the risks and be responsible for any injury, equipment damage or other loss that I might incur as a direct or indirect result of my participation in the NB Provincial Championship tournament. I agree to release Fencing-Escrime NB and their respective directors, officers, staff, coaches, tournament volunteers and officials of all responsibility for such injury, loss or damage.
