**Entry Fee**: Individual events - \$30, Team events - \$20 per fencer.

### Registration Deadline: Thursday, June 23rd at 8:00pm

**Membership**: All participants must hold a valid CFF "Fencing Member" license at the time of competition. Those registered as "Recreational Fencing Members" will need to upgrade their registration.

**Overlapping events**: A fencer registered in overlapping events may be asked to withdraw from one event if the overlap causes a significant delay in either event.

**Refund/Withdrawal:** Participants may withdraw from the competition before the close of check-in for any reason and receive a refund of event fees (minus processing applicable fees) provided they notify the organizers (see contact info above) and receive confirmation from them before that check-in time.

#### Format - Individual Events

One round of pools (5 touch bouts or 3 minutes) followed by 100% advancement to direct elimination (15 touch bouts or a maximum of three periods of 3 minutes) to final.

- In U13 events, direct elimination bouts will be to 10 touches or a maximum of two periods of 3 minutes.

- When fewer than six fencers are present for each gender, the event shall be mixed. U13 events will be mixed.

#### Format - TEAM events

Teams should be made of three fencers. Clubs may designate their own teams, and individuals may also arrange their teams before the competition. Individuals who do not have a team are encouraged to register for the event and let the organizers know that they are looking for a team.

Matches between teams go for 9 bouts and matches will be determined by the cumulative score of the bouts (i.e., to 45 points).

**CFF Ranking**: Only events with six or more participants will be submitted for CFF ranking.

#### **Required Equipment:**

- Fencing breeches must be worn. They must cover below the knee and long socks must be worn with breeches.
- A fencing sous-plastron is required.
- Masks must have a secure strap and be able to pass the 12 kg punch test.
- Female participants must wear a chest protector.
- It is recommended that all participants have at least 2 weapons and 2 body cords.

**Armoury:** Fencing mask and glove must be checked by the tournament armourer for safety prior to competing. Masks and gloves must be clean when being tested. Electric equipment will not be checked at this time, but the appropriate penalties will be assessed on piste by the referee if a fencer presents with equipment that does not work.

**COVID-19 Protocols:** Face masks are encouraged to be worn inside at all times by all participants, including athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators, unless actively fencing/warming up. We will update protocols closer to the tournaments if necessary. Participants who are feeling ill or have COVID symptoms should stay home.

**Canteen**: A light canteen will be provided.
